83/25 Update from JG Pears

The update was provided by JG Pears at 5pm on the day of the meeting. Points of note were:

- The roof on the bio-filter has been replaced and additional sprays have been installed.
- The feathers line is an ongoing project. They have started the removal of the old process line in order to commence Phase 4 of the project.
- There have been some complaints from the public regarding speeding HGVs through Grassthorne village.
- The new Environment Agency reporting system is not working well – there are delays in the EA forwarding complaints to JG Pears.
- The PC requested that JG Pears implement a system whereby email complainants receive an automated response to acknowledge receipt.
